

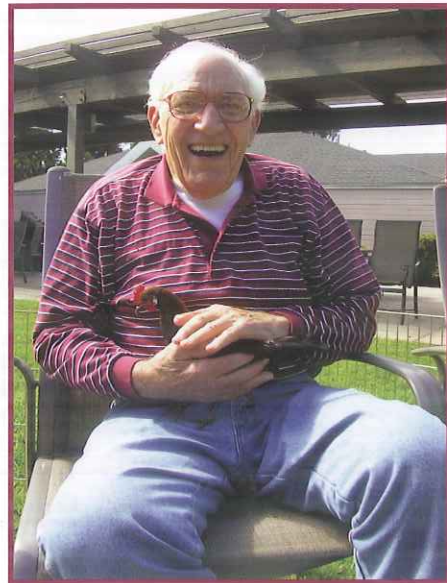

Our 25th year brought our clients, their families and our staff great joy and success! In addition to our regularly offered activities, such as music appreciation, dancing, painting, creative writing, etc, our days were also highlighted by a number of special events. Our annual Barnyard Day is always a tremendous hit with all age ranges, with an interactive petting zoo and pony rides! Likewise, our annual Easter Egg hunt continues to bring laughter and joy to both adults and children alike. Thanks to your generous donations of time, money and supplies, we now have an Inter-generational Garden, where we have an apple tree and a variety of fruit and vegetable plants. We were able to continue our expanded caregiver support with a grant from the Council on Aging Family Caregiver Support program. The new Steinke Resource Center was established to support our caregivers and families by providing a myriad of educational materials such as books, videos, online resources and training/counseling sessions. The needs of caregivers are often overshadowed in a family's effort to manage their loved one's care. Respite & Research for Alzheimer's Disease recognizes the importance of the whole family in providing supportive and effective care. Specialized grants also allowed us to diversify our offerings to include a Laughter Workshop and a Container Gardening Class providing outlets for expression, while our ongoing caregiver Social Hour offers the opportunity to meet and enjoy the company of others who share similar joys and challenges. Looking forward, we will continue evolving to meet the needs of our participants and caregivers with new programs such as a Men's Group and Frontal Lobe Dementia support groups, yoga, Medi-Cal and Medi-Care information sessions and much more. We are particularly excited about the new Edmondson Living Center which will be opening this next fiscal year. The Edmondson Living Center will provide long term living and overnight respite care with programming connected to our Alzheimer's Activity Center.
